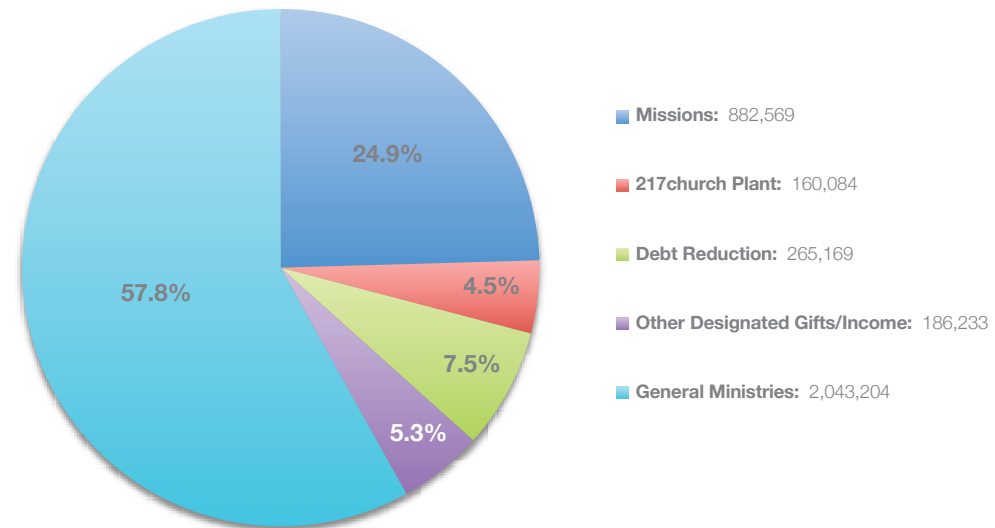

Financial Snapshot

- We are planning for a **5.6% increase** in total giving in 2010.
- General budget is planned at **\$2.8 million for 2010**.
- In 2009, **the mortgage was paid in full** releasing our 10% “debt reduction” line item in the budget for new growth opportunities.
- In 2010, the 10% “debt reduction” line item will be split between local (capital) growth and church planting.

The Princeton Alliance Church mortgage has been paid in full.

This is 16 years in advance. In 2006 we began our aggressive 10% commitment towards debt reduction. Through your generous giving we far exceeded our debt reduction goal.

Weekly giving is vital to Princeton Alliance Church.

It is the backbone that allows us to fulfill the vision and mission that God has specifically called us to. General Fund giving covers critical ministries of the church including Children’s Ministries, Adult Ministries, Student Ministries, Communications and Celebration Arts. The General Fund giving also allows us to maintain our facility. A few milestones from 2009 provide insight into how these funds are used:

- In an effort to improve communications within our congregation, community, and around the globe, a communications team was created.
- Investing in people through training and spiritual coaching, The Discipleship Coaching program was launched as a spiritual development model that can be exponentially replicated through out Princeton Alliance Church.
- Resources have been invested in enhancing our web site princetonalliance.org
- Volunteers reconfigured the Chapel to create a venue that is more inviting to students and adults.
- A spiritual growth plan is in development to take our children from diapers to diplomas.

The sum of our work is to ensure that we as a church honor Jesus in a way that stewards all the resources that He has given us (money, equipment, property, staff).
